

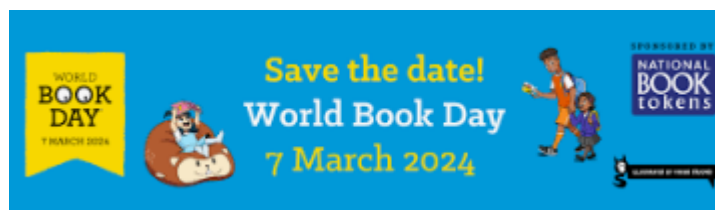


FEBRUARY NEWSLETTER

WINTER ILLNESS
